

ONGES TRIBE

The Onges are an indigenous tribe that resides on Little Andaman Island, part of the Andaman and Nicobar Islands in the Bay of Bengal. They are one of the most isolated tribes in the world and are primarily hunter-gatherers and fishermen, relying on the island's forests and surrounding seas for sustenance. Their traditional



lifestyle includes fishing with spears and nets, hunting small animals like cane rats, and gathering fruits, roots, and tubers. They use simple tools made from stone, bone, and wood. The Onges speak the Onge language, a critically endangered language within the Great Andamanese language family. However, due to their limited contact with the outside world, this language is at risk of extinction, with only a few fluent speakers remaining.

Historically, the Onges, like many other indigenous groups in the Andaman Islands, have suffered from external influences such as disease, colonialism, and the encroachment of modernity. The tribe's population was severely reduced by smallpox and other diseases introduced by outsiders in the 19th and 20th centuries. In response, the Indian government has established a protection zone around their territory to safeguard their way of life and

prevent further exploitation. While government efforts have aimed to preserve their culture, including providing basic healthcare and educational opportunities, the Onges maintain a deeply rooted sense of cultural independence and prefer limited contact with the outside world.

Their social structure is

organized around small family-based groups, and their spirituality is closely tied to nature, with animist beliefs that attribute spiritual significance to animals, trees, and other natural elements. The Onges' traditional dwellings are simple huts made from palm leaves and bamboo, blending harmoniously with their environment. Despite efforts to integrate them into the modern world, the Onges remain a symbol of resilience, with their population hovering around 150-200 individuals. However, their survival is threatened by the ongoing challenges of health issues, environmental changes, and the encroachment of external influences. Their existence represents a rare and vital connection to a way of life that is increasingly disappearing in the modern world.





BASANT PANCHMI CELEBRATION:

Making the small extra effort to decide on how much time you need to allot for each task can also help you recognize potential problems before they arise. That way you can make plans for dealing with them.
